

## TIPS FOR TEACHERS OF CHILDREN:

We sometimes share the gospel with groups in church settings. Seriously consider these issues:

- \* Be committed to reminding children over and over that you are available at any time to talk about Jesus and becoming a Christian or to talk and to pray together.
- \* Determine ahead of time the ages of the children who will be included in group settings where the gospel will be shared.
- \* Keep it brief. Children have limited attention spans.
- \* Consider using a response card for an invitation instead of a “show of hands” to lower peer pressure.
- \* Have a follow-up plan. Read together Hebrews 13:5b and 1 John 1:9 in the child’s Bible and underline them. Talk about how Jesus will never leave him, and even though he is a Christian, there will be times when he makes wrong choices. God will always forgive him.
- \* Always encourage a child to talk with his parents/caregiver about his decision to become a Christian.
